Dear ICSAtlanta Parents and Guardians:

At International Charter School of Atlanta, we are very proud of our teachers and feel they are ready for the coming school year and are prepared to give your child a high-quality education. The purpose of this letter is to inform parents that ICSAtlanta is required to meet federal regulations under the Every Students Succeeds Act (ESSA).

In compliance with the requirements of the ESSA, you have the right to request the following information:

- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which State qualifications or licensing criteria have been waived;
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher;
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications.

Please rest assured that our staff is committed to helping your child reach his or her maximum academic potential throughout their school career. That commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and delivering quality instruction to your child.
