

ICSATLANTA ASP POLICY AND GUIDELINES

The ICSAtlanta ASP staff wants to ensure your student a safe and enjoyable experience in our after school program. Please read the following policies and guidelines. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the ASP Director.

- A PIN (personal identification number) sign out is required to pick up students. No sharing of PIN numbers is allowed.
- PIN numbers are located in the personal tab of the ASP parent portal.
- Students must be personally escorted from the program area. The ICSAtlanta Staff will
 only release students to adults authorized on the pick-up list (entered in ASP Parent
 Portal).
- Students must follow the rules as written in the ICSAtlanta student code of ethics. Failure
 to adhere to these rules will result in disciplinary action which may include suspension or
 expulsion from the program.
 - Minor infractions: will result in a verbal/written warning. Minor infractions include, but are not limited to, inappropriate language/behavior, disrespect, and inappropriate teasing or horse-playing. Only 2 written warnings will be allowed. Warning #3 will result in 1-5 day suspension at the discretion of the ASP Director.
 - Major infractions: will result in a written warning and immediate 2-5 day suspension at the discretion of the ASP Director. Major infractions include, but not limited to, physical harm caused to another student or staff member, repeated bullying, and/or excessive disrespect. Major infractions of the rules may also result in permanent expulsion from the program.
 - No refunds will be given to days lost as a result of suspension or expulsion from the program.
- The ICSAtlanta afterschool program ends at 6:30 PM. Any pickup after 6:30 PM will result in a \$1.00 per minute late fee. This fee will be automatically deducted from the credit/debit card on file. Parents are allowed 2 late pick-ups per school calendar year per student. A third late pick-up will result in a one to three (1-3) day suspension. Further late pick-ups will result in expulsion from ICSAtlanta's ASP program.
 - ICSAtlanta staff will attempt to contact parents first and will then proceed to the listed emergency contacts. The ICSAtlanta ASP Director will notify the Department of Family and Children's Services (DFCS) if any student is not picked up within one hour of the close of the program.
- The after school program requires a TWO-WEEK WRITTEN/EMAIL notice of withdrawal
 of a participant to be given or emailed to the ICSAtlanta ASP Director, not instructors.
 Until such notice is received by the ICSAtlanta After School Program Director, parents
 are responsible for fees.

- Our goal is to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all students. Any student
 deemed ill which includes, but is not limited to, oral temperatures of 101 degrees or
 higher, and/or any contagious symptoms such as rashes, sore throat, congestion,
 vomiting, etc. will not be allowed to attend ASP. If your student has been exposed to or
 contracted any serious communicable or infectious disease, he or she may not return
 until accompanied by a note from the student's physician. When you are notified that
 your child is ill, arrangements must be made for immediate pick-up.
- The ICSAtlanta ASP Director will inform parents of any incidents, including illnesses, injuries, and exposure to communicable diseases and will post when a communicable disease has been introduced into the program. If medication needs to be distributed, please contact the After School Program Director so arrangements can be made.
- Weather-Related School Closings. ICSAtlanta ASP will be cancelled if ICSAtlanta closes
 due to inclement weather or any other such emergency situation. In the event of an
 unplanned early release by ICSAtlanta, students must be picked-up at or before
 ICSAtlanta's communicated dismissal time.
