#### JOINTLY DEVELOPED

The parents, students, and staff of the International Charter School of Atlanta (ICSAtlanta) partnered together to develop this school-parent compact for achievement. Teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added input about the types of support they needed, and students told us what would help them learn. #### SCHOOL/TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

ICSAtlanta will:

Grade level lead teachers will maintain blogs that provide important gradelevel wide information and guidance to help parents and students be continually informed and involved in the classroom.

Teachers will work collaboratively within their grade level to create a 'Week at a Glance' document each week for each grade level that summarizes learning objectives, gives vocabulary words in the first and second language, outlines the phonics rules to be studied, and informs parents of formative and summative assessments to be given during the week.

Teachers will plan monthly with their language track to ensure cohesiveness in the learning across grade levels.

Teachers will plan monthly with their vertical language colleagues to ensure learning is captured and reinforced across grade levels.

Teachers and administrators will plan weekly as a grade level to ensure cross-curricular connections are made to promote authentic learning experiences.

ICSAtlanta will provide access to multiple online learning resources, including MobyMax, MyOn, Spelling City, Linguascope, RazPlus, Nearpod, BrainPop, etc.

ICSAtlanta will publish and distribute a per unit PYP newsletter that describes objectives and activities taught during each of the PYP units.

# PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

We, as parents, will:

Read the blogs, email blasts, ICSAtlanta Facebook page, ICSAtlanta website, and PYP newsletters regularly to stay informed and find resources for my child(ren).

Actively participate in my child's education by working with him/her at home including reading, homework, etc.
