

Below are the basic supplies needed for all 6th -8th grade students.
An additional subject-specific list may be sent home once students receive their schedule.

6th – 8th Grade Supply List

- ☐ **ICSAtlanta agenda** w/student handbook is required (Cost: \$8.00, if lost replacement cost: \$10.00) – purchase during open house and the front office (during first week of school)

Individual supplies: Supplies students should have daily.

- ☐ 1 zippered pencil pouch (*for everyday needs*) *
- ☐ 1 plastic pencil box (*kept in locker, used for specific projects*)
- *Refill pencil bag, box, and folders as necessary throughout the year
- ☐ Earbuds (labeled with first and last name) (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - ☐ Handheld pencil sharpener with cover (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - ☐ #2 Pencils sharpened (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - ☐ 1 pink eraser (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - ☐ 1 Highlighter pens (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - ☐ Sharpie Marker (*keep in pencil box*)
 - ☐ 1 - 12 count colored Crayola pencils (*keep in pencil box*)
 - ☐ Glue stick (*keep in pencil box*)
 - ☐ 1 – 10 count classic fine tip Crayola markers (*keep in pencil box*)
 - ☐ Scissors (*keep in pencil box*)
 - ☐ 6-in ruler (*keep in pencil pouch; needed in Math class*)

Use a Sharpie pen to label all your materials!

Girls

- ☐ 1 box of sandwich sized bags
- ☐ 1 ink joy pen of each color: black, blue, and red

Boys

- ☐ 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- ☐ 1 box of gallon sized bags

- ☐ 5 – 1" white view binders (one for each core subject: Science, Social Studies, ELA, Math, and Foreign Language) – **NO trapper keepers.**
- ☐ 5 – 3-hole punched pocket folders in the following colors: Green (Science), Orange (Social Studies), Blue (ELA), Red (Math), Yellow (Foreign Language)
- ☐ six sets of 5-tab dividers (2 for Social Studies, 1 for ELA, 1 for Math, 1 for SC, 1 for L2)
- ☐ Several packs of loose-leaf, wide ruled notebook paper – distribute papers to binders (needed **daily** throughout the school year in all classes) *
- ☐ 1 Quad-Ruled/Graph-Ruled Spiral Notebook (Math, preferable: RED)
- ☐ 1 Composition Book (ELA)
- ☐ Calculators: 6th Grade: Simple 4 function calculator,
7th & 8th Grade: Scientific Calculator (labeled with first and last name), Preferred: TI 30XS Multi-view or TI-36X Pro
- ☐ 7th Grade: Drawing Compass (needed for homework assignments) – preferred: Safe-T compass (found on Amazon)

General supplies: Supplies will be turned into the Homeroom (HR) teacher during Open House or the first days of school
