Student and Parent Expectations

Students should engage with their teacher, which includes but is not limited to participating in live learning sessions and completing assignments.

Students and families should make every effort to access their online, Google Meet sessions.

Depending on the student's age, student or parent should maintain frequent contact with the teacher(s).

Attendance: Student attendance will be taken during our 2020-2021 LTSC days. Attendance will reflect participation and engagement in a student's live, online learning sessions. If a family's schedule does not allow for attendance in live sessions, you will need to contact and communicate with your child's teachers. If the teacher has been contacted by the parent and all classwork has been correctly completed within 24 hours, the student will not be marked as absent for the online learning session.

Special Student Services

Students who receive special support services such as Special Education, English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL), Early Intervention Program (EIP), Remedial Education Program (REP), or 504 will continue to receive their services through our 2020-2021 LTSC days.

Gifted Services

Students served through ICSAtlanta's gifted (4th-5th) or Advanced Content (AC) (6th-8th) programs will continue to receive services through our 2020-2021 LTSC days.

Milestones

The Georgia Department of Education has submitted for a waiver from the US Department of Education for the 2020-2021 Milestones test administration. We will let parents know if and when this waiver is approved.

School Calendar & Breaks
